

Wyoming State USBC

Graduating Senior Scholarship Application

PURPOSE: This scholarship is available to any current graduating male or female senior, who is currently a member of the Wyoming USBC Youth and is currently bowling in a Wyoming USBC Youth sanctioned league.

PAYMENT: The number of scholarships and dollar amounts to be awarded are to be determined at June board meeting.

Please note: All listed requirements should be included with the application in order to receive full consideration for this scholarship. Each scholarship will be paid to the college, university or trade school of the applicant's choice at the beginning of the first semester, or at the applicant's request, at the beginning of the second semester. The initial payment must be requested within eighteen (18) months of the notification of your successful application, unless the Wyoming USBC BA Board of Directors approves any extenuating circumstances that are brought to their attention in writing by the applicant

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum qualifications for this scholarship by an applicant are as follows:

1. Must be a current Wyoming USBC Youth member, with at least three years of consecutive participation in Wyoming USBC Youth sanctioned leagues.
2. Be a graduating senior of any accredited High School within the state of Wyoming or a Wyoming Home School graduate during the current year.
3. Have maintained a grade point average 2.5 or higher in the last two (2) semesters preceding the mid-term of the current year. (The junior year semesters are sufficient if the first semester of the senior year is unavailable).
4. Plan to attend an accredited institution of higher learning as a full time student for the term following graduation.

LIST OF REQUIRED ITEMS TO SUBMIT:

1. Completed, signed scholarship application form.
2. Completed coach/proprietor evaluation sheet.
2. Current **SIGNED, OFFICIAL** transcript or most current **SIGNED** report card.
3. Minimum of at least two (2) letters of recommendation from the following list of individuals who know the applicant and their qualifications:
 - A. High School official/administrator/counselor/or teacher
 - B. Associate other than a family member: employer, businessperson, member of the clergy, etc.
 - C. A bowling league or association officer from the local level.
4. Cover letter from the applicant including the following information:
 - a. Tournaments bowled
 - b. Leagues bowled
 - c. The reason you need this scholarship
 - d. Future plans
5. Current photo of the applicant (may be scanned if desired)
