- 2. Be a graduating senior of any accredited High School within the state of Wyoming or a Wyoming Home School graduate during the current year.
- 3. Have maintained a grade point average 2.5 or higher in the last two (2) semesters preceding the mid-term of the current year. (The junior year semesters are sufficient if the first semester of the senior year is unavailable).
- 4. Plan to attend an accredited institution of higher learning as a full time student for the term following graduation.
